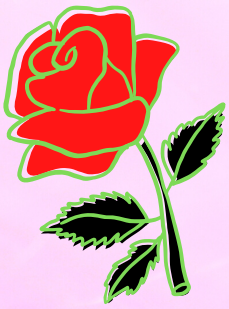

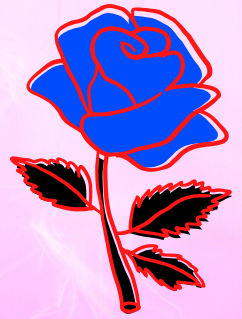

Scientific-Humanitarian Committee



1897 - 1933

The SHC was the first ever internationally recognized Queer Rights organization.

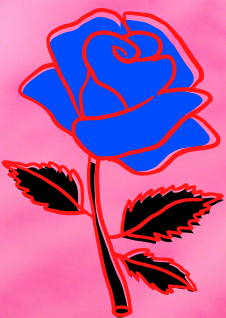
This institution had documented:

Homosexuality, Transness, STDs, Queer identity, History, the repeal of German Law Paragraph 175 etc.

The people who supported them during the time were **leftists** (Anarchists, Communists, Socialists etc.)

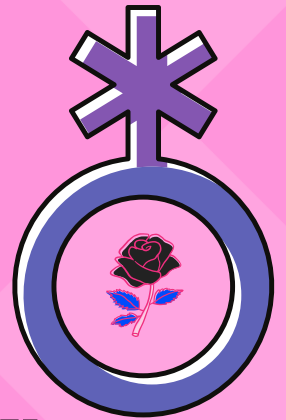
As the Police, Church, and State were intertwined and outcasted any deviant sexualities or genders

This led to the Free Love Movement (more information on next page)



Free Love Movement

The Free Love Movement is a social movement that advocates for the separation of the state and have it only concern the people involved.

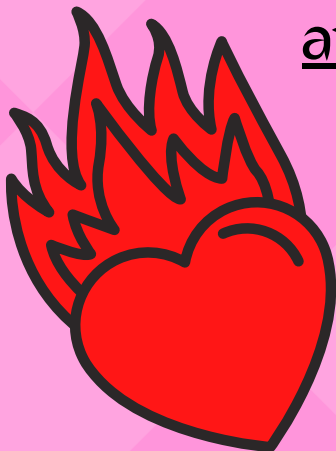


Anarchism and free love are **inherently** **against pedophilia** and it has been heavily disavowed since it attempted to creep into other movements.



Free Love demands that non-heteronormative desires deviate against normalcy while advocating for intersectionality and radical consent

Now the Marriages of Queers, Transitioning, Rights & Protections of Queers are all decided and attacked by the state and media.

Homophile Movement

LGBTQIA+ 1933 - 1969 LGBTQIA+

After the 1930s most queers went the the Communist Party as methods of organizing via underground media



Unsurprisingly the Communist Party reversed most/all progress from the leftists in the 1850s

This lead to the Communist Party enacting the first "Don't Ask Don't Tell" policy.



(Lenin was only communist in name and not in practice)



The Homophile Movement then showed a split that carried on into future queer generations: Reform or Resist?



Stonewall

1969 - 1980

“A relatively small group of white middle-aged males are in a position to make the major decisions to define the boundaries within which all of us must function. It is by and large this group who benefit from the existing distribution of resources; the productivity of American Capitalism and the success of the ideological persuasion are such that the great majority of persons rally to defend the system that enables this minority to maintain their dominance.”

- Dennis Altman, *Homosexual: Oppression and Liberation* (1972)

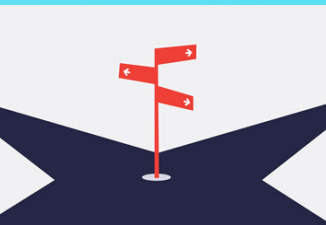
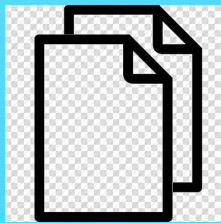


This movement was started because of a police raid on the Stonewall Inn and most groups that supported them were leftists



Eventually & unfortunately during the mid 1970s the radicals turned from anarchism and destroying unjustified power structures to liberal reformism and assimilationism

1980 - Present

Now that queer marriage is legal, rather than allowing queers to create alternative social relations to the existing power structures.

we are instead expected to copy heteronormative standards and on the other side of the coin, submit to homonormativity and whiteness as a norm for socializing.



Our Latiné and Black queer-trans lovers and communities are DISPROPORTIONATELY MURDERED in cold blood for existing! because it makes the hetero-cisnormative power structures uncomfortable!

Anarchists use

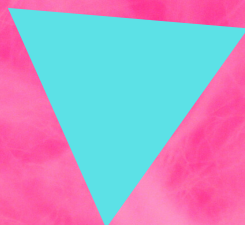
Intersectionality/identity politics to
